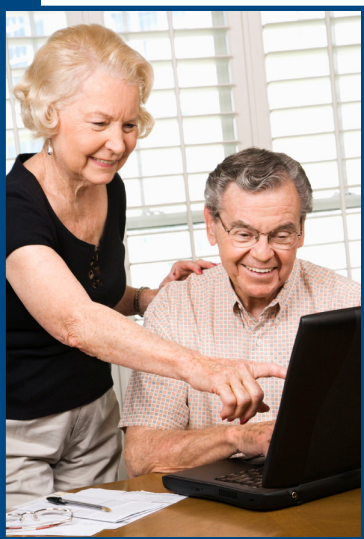

It is dedicated to providing objective and confidential health benefits counseling services and is not affiliated with, nor does it receive funding from, the insurance industry.

- Counseling people with Medicare through the annual prescription drug plan enrollment period
- Connecting with seniors who have limited incomes to help them save money on health care costs
